

The purpose of this event is to provide a fun, end of the season tournament that promotes creativity/originality and also gives skiers the opportunity to enjoy the Northwoods of Wisconsin while participating in a fun and original waterski tournament. There will be awards and cash prizes, but the emphasis of this weekend will be fun and camaraderie.

All-Star Tournament Format

- Each team will consist of 22 total members maximum. This number includes: boat drivers, spotters, dock crew, sound crew, announcers and skiers. Also, there must be at least 4 skiers of each gender. Entry fee is \$200, \$250 after 7/1/08.
- Team members are not restricted to WWSF or USA-WS team affiliations, this is an All-Star Tournament and rosters can be composed of any 22 individuals.
- Each team member will be required to have USA-WS affiliation and to sign the standard USA-WS waiver.
- Each show will be limited to 45 minutes of performance time (plus 15 minutes setup and 10 minutes to tear down). * pending USA-WS approval/sanctioning
- Each show will be scored on the basis of 11 acts (instead of the normal 13).
* pending USA-WS approval/sanctioning
- Each team will use the two tournament supplied tow boats and tournament supplied pickup boat (each team will be required to use a minimum of one pickup boat with a driver and a spotter during their show).
- There will be one non-motorized floating dock for use (additional floating docks will not be allowed).
- Standard NSSA rules will be used to determine scores (adjusted for eleven acts). However, the final score will include bonus points – 100 for 1st, 50 for 2nd and 25 for 3rd awarded for coolest/most original act, voted on by each team (one vote from each team and cannot vote for own team's acts). This final component is to encourage creativity and make the tournament more fun to spectators and participants. * pending USA-WS approval/sanctioning
- Spotters, sound crew and dock crew can participate on more than one team, but cannot ski or announce in more than one show. Also, if a team is under the 25 person limit and needs spotters, the tournament host will provide capable persons for those rolls.
- There will be a practice session for tournament drivers, in order to “get the feel” of the tournament supplied tow boats and show site. This will be held prior to the start of the tournament (time TBA).

Tournament Awards

- Team Placements: 1st - \$1500
2nd - \$750
3rd - \$400
- Most creative/original/coolest act. The: *Did You See That!?* Award
 - Best/Worst Yard Sale (crash)
 - Top Male and Female performers

To be provided by the tournament host for use during show:

- Two waterski tow boats
 - One pickup boat
- Sound system consisting of two microphones and two CD-Players and inputs for one additional microphone base and two music inputs.
 - One stationary floating dock
 - Locker rooms/changing area
- Incidental ski equipment (we cannot supply all the skis for a pyramid, but we will try to help out in case your teams is short a ski, rope or flomo, etc.).

Also to be provided by the tournament host:

- Free camping
- Shuttle between tournament site and campground (approx. 2 miles)
 - Free post tournament concert at campground
